Nagarkot is also the most beautiful place where you can see the sunset and sunrise views of the Himalayas of Mount Everest. Nagarkot is situated in Bhaktapur district and it is perfect for the mountain view.

## **Package Itinerary**

### **Day : 01 -Kathmandu arrival**

Our guide will receive you and welcome with garlands at Kathmandu airport followed by transfer to your hotel. Overnight at Hotel Annapurna On BB.

### **Day : 02 -Drive to Kathmandu - Pokhara and Manakamana too**

After Breakfast we will drive to Pokhara. Visit Manakamana Temple and again continue our drive to Pokhara. Transfer to hotel. Overnight at Shangri-La Village Resort on BB.

### **Day : 03 -Pokhara Full Day Sight Seeing**

Early morning wake up call and transfer to the base of Sarangkot. Hike about Half an hour to the Top. Enjoy the magnificent views of Sunrise over the Himalayas. After breakfast, Full day Sight Seeing of Pokhara City including 01 hour boating on Phewa Lake. With the visit to Tal Barahi Temple and visit to Bindhyavasini temple, Davi's falls. Pokhara: The rare combinations of snow clad peaks and snow fed lakes and rivers has helped to make the valley of Pokhara (200 km) one of the most picturesque natural attractions in the kingdom. A must for all visitors to Pokhara valley is the Phewa Lake. Overnight at Shangri-La Village Resort on BB.

### **Day : 04-Pokhara Kathmandu Drive and Nagarkot**

After breakfast drive to Kathmandu. Continue drive to Bhaktapur. Lunch at Local restaurant and Visit of Bhaktapur City Durbar Square Bhadgaon (Bhaktapur), a Newar city founded in the 9th century. Visit the ancient gateway, Durbar Square the Royal Residential Quarter of Bhupatindra Malla, famous five storied temple of Nyatapola in Pagoda style, Batsala temple, Bhairavnath temple, Duttatraya temple, Pujari Math and Palace of 55 windows. This evening we spent in Bhaktapur to feel the medieval city. Drive to Nagarkot. Transfer to the hotel. Enjoy the sunset views based on the weather condition. Overnight at Hotel Fort Resort or Same on BB Plan.

### **Day : 05 -Full Day Kathmandu Sightseeing.**

Early Morning wake-up call followed by Tea/Coffee. Enjoy the magnificent views of Sunrise over the Himalayas. AM: Visit of Pashupatinath and Bouddhanath Visit Pashupatinath area where you can see famous Lord Shiva temple and Hindu cremation ground. Though you are not allowed to go inside the

temple as it is strictly for Hindus only, you can clearly see the temple and the activities from the eastern bank of the Bagmati river. The two-tier golden roof and silver doors of the temple are famous all over the world. Later visit Bouddhanath, the 2500 years old Buddhist stupa in the Valley built in 5th century with four pairs of eyes of Lord Buddha in four cardinal directions keeping an eternal watch over the people and their doings. You will find Buddhist pilgrims from Tibet going round the stupa spinning the prayer wheels. PM: Half-day tour of Kathmandu city= In this tour visit the 17th Century Durbar complex and Hanuman Dhoka, temple of living goddess, Narayan Mandir, and Kasthmandap a wooden temple built from a single tree, Shiva Paravati temple, great Bell and Drum, Seto Bhairav, Kal Bhairav and Taleju Temple. Transfer to the hotel after Sightseeing and Overnight at hotel Annapurna or Same on BB plan

### **Day : 06 -Full Day Kathmandu**

Am Visit Patan City Durbar Square. Located just across the Bagmati River from Kathmandu sits Patan, one of Nepal's largest cities, and with a rich tradition of local art and handicrafts, it's a must-see for shoppers. Like Kathmandu, Patan has its own Durbar Square, a central plaza surrounded by an array of temples and palace buildings. While you're wandering the square, don't miss the excellent collection at the museum housed within one of the ancient palace buildings, as well as the stone temple dedicated to the god Krishna that dates back to 1647. Free for Personal Activities and Shopping. Evening: Rickshaw ride to Thamel and back to Hotel after the Traditional Nepali cultural dances with Traditional Foods at Local restaurant in Thamel. Overnight at hotel Annapurna or Same on BB plan.

### **Day : 07 -Final Departure**

Free till final departure. Transfer to the International Airport for final departure.
